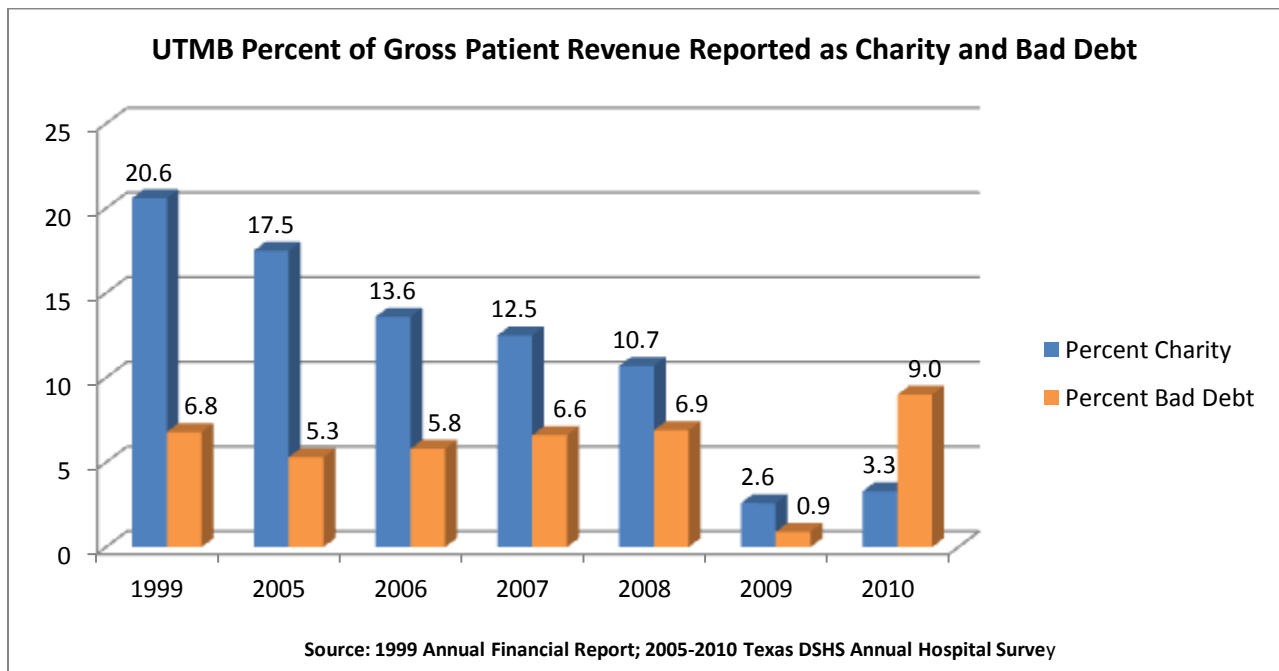
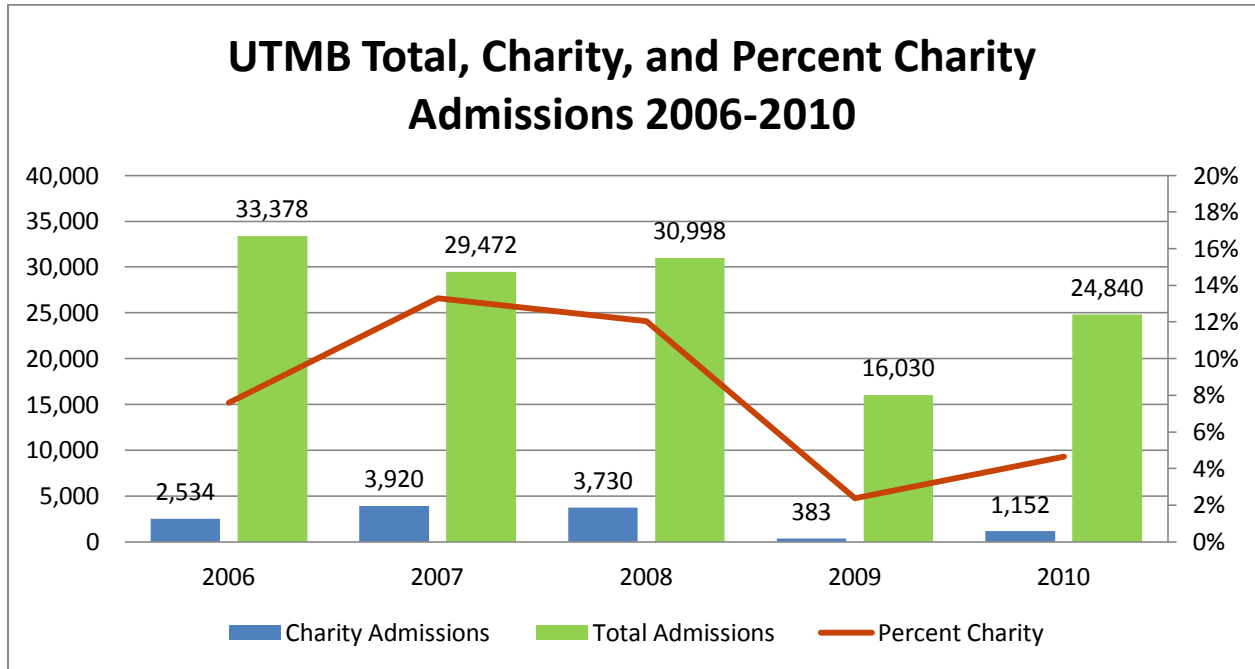

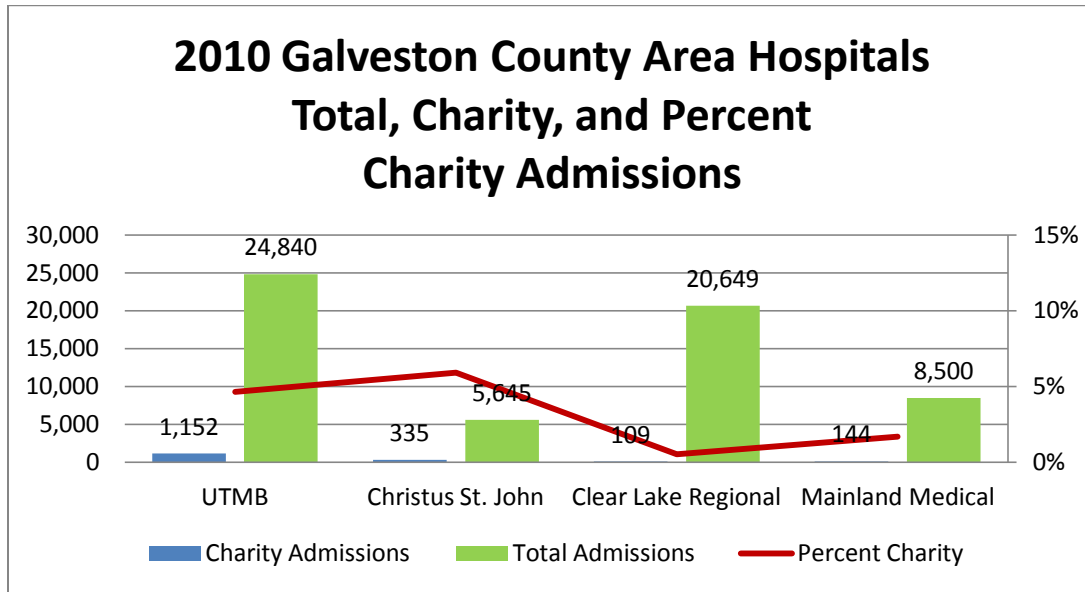
In 2010, for the first time in recent years, UTMB reported a greater percent of gross patient revenue as bad debt as compared to charity care.
